LEVY 21-218

Residents in SRF District will soon be asked to approve the local option tax of 0.20 per \$1000 of assessed valuation that was previously approved by the voters in 2008, 2012 & 2016. This is a continuation of that same amount and would run through the 2028-29 fiscal year.

Approval of this measure would allow the District to retain a full time fire chief and pay expenses related to that position. The budget for our Chief is one of the lowest, if not the lowest, in our county.

Remember, this proposal does NOT raise taxes, it extends our long-time levy that funds our most important position of Fire Chief.
